RE: Waive Jones Act for Puerto Rico recovery

Dear President Trump:

The Jones Act Waiver signed on September 8th has been very helpful to my state of Florida and other states who experienced severe disruptions of the oil supply system resulting from Hurricanes Harvey and Irma.

Now, Puerto Rico is in desperate need of the same relief regarding disruptions to the oil supply system and virtually every other supply system.
