



GOVERNMENT SPENDING AS A % SHARE OF ECONOMY




PROJECTED REAL GDP GROWTH



DEBT HELD BY THE PUBLIC AS % OF GDP














CBO vs. HBC BUDGET DEFICIT PROJECTIONS






THE LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE IS HISTORICALLY LOW



RISE IN IMPROPER PAYMENTS




IMPROPER PAYMENTS BY GOVERNMENT PROGRAM IN FY 2016

FY 2017 TOTAL REVENUE




FEDERAL MEDICARE SPENDING


