Applications must be submitted to “210 W. Birch Street, Suite #201, Brea, CA 92821, Attention: Academy Nominations”. Applications can be submitted by mail or delivered in person. Each application must be submitted in a single envelope.

Do not submit applications in binders, booklets, or with plastic covers on the pages. Applications should have applicant name and page numbers clearly marked at the bottom of each page. Submitted applications must be complete containing all required materials including letters of recommendation. Do not staple application.

Communication: Email is the preferred mode of contact with student. Please make sure your email is legible. If you have a school email that you do not access often we recommend that you create an easily accessible email address that you will have constant access to and check regularly.
