A BILL

To prohibit the sale of shark fins, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Shark Fin Sales Elimi-
- 5 nation Act of 2017".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SALE OF SHARK FINS.
- 7 (a) Prohibition.—Except as provided in section 3,
- 8 no person shall possess, offer for sale, sell, or purchase
- 9 any shark fin or product containing any shark fin.

1	(b) Penalty.—For purposes of section 308(a) of the
2	Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Manage-
3	ment Act (16 U.S.C. 1858(a)), a violation of this section
4	shall be treated as an act prohibited by section 307 of
5	that Act (16 U.S.C. 1857).
6	SEC. 3. EXEMPTION FOR TRADITIONAL FISHERIES, EDU-
7	CATION, AND SCIENCE.
8	Section 2 shall not apply with respect to possession
9	of a shark fin that was taken lawfully under a State, terri-
10	torial, or Federal license or permit to take or land sharks,
11	if the shark fin is separated from the shark in a manner
12	consistent with the license or permit and is—
13	(1) destroyed or discarded;
14	(2) used for noncommercial subsistence pur-
15	poses in accordance with State or territorial law; or
16	(3) used solely for display or research purposes
17	by a museum, college, or university, or other person
18	under a State or Federal permit to conduct non-
19	commercial scientific research.
20	SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.
21	In this Act:
22	(1) Shark.—The term "shark" means any spe-
23	cies of the orders Pristiophoriformes,
24	Squatiniformes, Squaliformes, Hexanchiformes,

Lamniformes, Carchariniformes, Orectolobiformes, 1 2 and Heterodontiformes. 3 (2) SHARK FIN.—The term "shark fin" means the raw, dried, or otherwise processed detached fin, 4 or the raw, dried, or otherwise processed detached 5 tail, of a shark. 6 SEC. 5. STATE AUTHORITY. 8 Nothing in this Act affects any right of a State or territory of the United States to adopt or enforce any regulation or standard that is more stringent than a regula-

tion or standard in effect under this Act.
