- 5 ficiary 2nd Amendment Rights Protection Act".

SEC. 2. USE OF DETERMINATIONS MADE BY THE COMMIS SIONER.

3 (a) TITLE II.—Section 205(j) of the Social Security
4 Act (42 U.S.C. 405(j)) is amended by adding at the end
5 the following:

6 "(11) No determination by the Commissioner of So-7 cial Security with respect to an individual, including a de-8 termination that benefits under this title to which such 9 individual is entitled shall be paid to a representative 10 payee, shall be considered to be a determination that the 11 individual has been adjudicated as a mental defective for purposes of subsections (d)(4) and (g)(4) of section 922 12 13 of title 18, United States Code.".

14 (b) TITLE XVI.—Section 1631(a)(2) of such Act (42
15 U.S.C. 1383(a)(2)) is amended by adding at the end the
16 following:

17 "(J) No determination by the Commissioner of Social 18 Security with respect to an individual, including a deter-19 mination that benefits under this title to which such indi-20 vidual is entitled shall be paid to a representative payee, 21 shall be considered to be a determination that the indi-22 vidual has been adjudicated as a mental defective for purposes of subsections (d)(4) and (g)(4) of section 922 of 23 24 title 18, United States Code.".
