## A BILL

To provide that the owner of a water right may use the water for the cultivation of industrial hemp, if otherwise authorized by State law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Industrial Hemp  
5 Water Rights Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. USE OF WATER FOR INDUSTRIAL HEMP CULTIVA-**  
2 **TION.**

3 (a) DEFINITION OF INDUSTRIAL HEMP.—In this sec-  
4 tion, the term “industrial hemp” has the meaning given  
5 the term in section 7606(b) of the Agricultural Act of  
6 2014 (7 U.S.C. 5940(b)).

7 (b) USE FOR INDUSTRIAL HEMP CULTIVATION.—  
8 Notwithstanding the Controlled Substances Act (21  
9 U.S.C. 801 et seq.), chapter 81 of title 41, United States  
10 Code, or any other Federal law, an owner of an absolute  
11 or conditional or reserved water right, including a feder-  
12 ally recognized Tribe, or an entity that receives or distrib-  
13 utes water contracted from the Federal Government, may,  
14 pursuant to applicable water law, use or sell for use by  
15 another person the water subject to the water right or the  
16 contract, as applicable, for the cultivation of industrial  
17 hemp, regardless of whether the water has passed through  
18 a Federal water project, if the growth or cultivation of  
19 industrial hemp is otherwise authorized under the laws of  
20 the State or Tribe in whose jurisdiction in which such use  
21 occurs.
