A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize school-based health centers, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “School-Based Health
5 Centers Reauthorization Act of 2020”.

3 (a) **ELIMINATION OF LIMITATION ON ELIGIBILITY OF**
4 **HEALTH CENTERS.—**

5 (1) **REPEAL.—**Section 399Z–1(f)(3) of the
6 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280h–5(f)(3))
7 is amended by striking subparagraph (B).

8 (2) **CONFORMING CHANGE.—**Section 399Z–
9 1(f)(3) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
10 280h–5(f)(3)) is amended by striking “LIMITA-
11 TIONS” and all that follows through “Any provider
12 of services” and inserting “LIMITATION.—Any pro-
13 vider of services”.

14 (b) **AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—**Section
15 399Z–1(l) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
16 280h–5(l)) is amended by striking “2010 through 2014”
17 and inserting “2021 through 2024”.
