4	(a) In General.—Subject to subsection (b), if the
5	Administrator of the Drug-Free Communities Support
6	Program determines that, as a result of the public health
7	emergency declared pursuant to section 319 of the Public
8	Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 247d) as a result of
9	COVID-19, an eligible coalition is unable to raise the
10	amount of non-Federal funds, including in-kind contribu-
11	tions, agreed to be raised by the coalition for a fiscal year
12	under an agreement entered into with the Administrator
13	pursuant to paragraph (1)(A) or (3)(D) of section 1032(b)
14	of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988 (21 U.S.C. 1532(b)),
