*Ordered*, That at a time to be determined by the Majority Leader, after consultation with the Republican Leader, the Senate proceed to executive session to consider the following nominations: Mark A. Barnett, of Virginia, to be a Judge of the United States Court of International Trade and Claire R. Kelly, of New York, to be a Judge of the United States Court of International Trade.

*Ordered further*, That there be 30 minutes for debate equally divided in the usual form; that upon the use or yielding back of time the Senate proceed to vote without intervening action or debate on the nominations in the order listed; *provided further*, that following the votes on the Barnett and Kelly nominations, the motions to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table with no intervening action or debate; that no further motions be in order; that the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate then resume legislative session.
