1	SEC. 81253. CONTINUED USE OF PICK-SLOAN MISSOURI
2	BASIN PROGRAM PROJECT USE POWER BY
3	THE KINSEY IRRIGATION COMPANY AND THE
4	SIDNEY WATER USERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT.
5	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—
6	(1) the Act of May 18, 1938 (52 Stat. 403,
7	chapter 250; 16 U.S.C. 833 et seq.), authorized the
8	completion, maintenance, and operation of the Fort
9	Peck project;
10	(2) section 2 of that Act (52 Stat. 404, chapter
11	250; 16 U.S.C. 833a) authorized and directed the
12	Bureau of Reclamation—
13	(A) to transmit and sell electric energy
14	generated by the Fort Peck project; and
15	(B) "to interconnect the Fort Peck project
16	with either private or with other Federal
17	projects and publicly owned power systems now
18	or hereafter constructed.";

1	(3) section 9 of the Act of December 22, 1944
2	(commonly known as the "Flood Control Act of
3	1944") (58 Stat. 891, chapter 665)—
4	(A) authorized the Missouri River Basin
5	Project, now known as the "Pick-Sloan Mis-
6	souri Basin Program" (referred to in this sec-
7	tion as the "Program");
8	(B) approved the comprehensive plan for
9	the Program set forth in Senate Document 191
10	and House Document 475, as revised and co-
11	ordinated by Senate Document 247, 78th Con-
12	gress;
13	(C) established a permanent administra-
14	tion for the development of the Missouri River
15	Basin; and
16	(D) incorporated the Fort Peck project as
17	part of the Program;
18	(4) in 1946, the Bureau of Reclamation entered
19	into project use power contracts to provide the
20	Kinsey Irrigation Company and the predecessor of
21	the Sidney Water Users Irrigation District electrical
22	service under the authority of the Act of May 18,
23	1938 (52 Stat. 403, chapter 250; 16 U.S.C. 833 et
24	seq.);

1	(5) since 1946, the Bureau of Reclamation has
2	approved 9 modifications to the project use power
3	contracts between the Bureau of Reclamation, the
4	Kinsey Irrigation Company, and the Sidney Water
5	Users Irrigation District;
6	(6) the project use power contracts in effect on
7	the date of enactment of this Act provide electric
8	service to the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the
9	Sidney Water Users Irrigation District at the Pro-
10	gram rate of 2.5 mills per kilowatt-hour, including
11	wheeling, through 2020; and
12	(7) the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sid-
13	ney Water Users Irrigation District have reasonably
14	relied on the authority of the Act of May 18, 1938
15	(52 Stat. 403, chapter 250; 16 U.S.C. 833 et seq.),
16	and the fact that the Bureau of Reclamation has
17	treated the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sid-
18	ney Water Users Irrigation District as irrigation
19	pumping units of the Program for more than 74
20	years.
21	(b) AUTHORIZATION.—Notwithstanding any other
22	provision of law and subject to subsection (c), the Sec-
23	retary of the Interior (acting through the Commissioner
24	of Reclamation) shall continue to treat the irrigation
25	pumping units known as the "Kinsey Irrigation Com-

- 1 pany" in Custer County, Montana, and the "Sidney Water
- 2 Users Irrigation District" in Richland County, Montana,
- 3 or any successor to the Kinsey Irrigation Company or Sid-
- 4 new Water Users Irrigation District, as irrigation pumping
- 5 units of the Program for the purposes of wheeling, admin-
- 6 istration, and payment of project use power.
- 7 (c) LIMITATION.—The quantity of power to be pro-
- 8 vided to the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sidney
- 9 Water Users Irrigation District (including any successor
- 10 to the Kinsey Irrigation Company or the Sidney Water
- 11 Users Irrigation District) under subsection (b) may not
- 12 exceed the maximum quantity of power provided to the
- 13 Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sidney Water Users
- 14 Irrigation District under the applicable contract for elec-
- 15 tric service in effect on the date of enactment of this Act.
