**OFFERED BY MRS. MILLER OF WEST VIRGINIA**

Page 753, after line 16, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 3014. PILOT PROGRAM ON DRUGGED DRIVING PRE-**  
2 **VENTION.**

3 Section 403 of title 23, United States Code, as  
4 amended by this Act, is further amended by adding at the  
5 end the following:

6 “(k) DRUGGED DRIVING PREVENTION PILOT PRO-  
7 GRAM.—

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after  
9 the date of enactment of this subsection, the Sec-  
10 retary of Transportation, acting through the Admin-  
11 istrator of the National Highway Traffic Safety Ad-  
12 ministration, shall establish a pilot program to cre-  
13 ate, and study the effects of, a public marketing  
14 campaign to raise awareness on driving while under  
15 the influence of prescription and over-the-counter  
16 medications.

17 “(2) CONSULTATION.—In implementing the  
18 pilot program, the Secretary may consult with phar-

1        macies, pharmaceutical companies, and govern-  
2        mental and nongovernmental organizations.

3            “(3) LOCATIONS.—The Secretary shall imple-  
4        ment the pilot program in States and regions that  
5        are most affected by the opioid epidemic.

6            “(4) SUNSET.—The pilot program shall termi-  
7        nate on the date that is 2 years after the date on  
8        which the pilot program is established.

9            “(5) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the  
10       date of termination of the pilot program, the Sec-  
11       retary shall submit to Congress a report on the re-  
12       sults of the study of the effects of the public mar-  
13       keting campaign.”.
