11	2022. Any amounts appropriated pursuant to this sub-
12	section shall remain available until September 30, 2023.
13	(b) USE.—Any amounts made available pursuant to
14	subsection (a)—
15	(1) shall be used only for providing assistance
16	to aliens released from the custody of the Depart-
17	ment of Homeland Security;
18	(2) notwithstanding sections 315 and 316(b) of
19	the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, shall
