

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 986, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MS. ADAMS OF NORTH CAROLINA**

Add at the end the following new section:

**1 SEC. 3. GAO REPORT ON STATE INNOVATION WAIVERS.**

2 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment  
3 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States  
4 shall submit to Congress a report reviewing the impacts  
5 and outcomes of waivers granted under section 1332 of  
6 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42  
7 U.S.C. 18052) with respect to States with such waivers  
8 in effect and recommending steps Congress and States can  
9 take to increase access to affordable, quality health insur-  
10 ance coverage for individuals, including the feasibility of  
11 a publicly-sponsored plan to the extent such plan is esti-  
12 mated to generate savings for the Federal government (as  
13 determined by the Chief Actuary of the Centers for Medi-  
14 care & Medicaid Services) and meets all other statutory  
15 requirements under such section.
