## A BILL

To require elementary schools and secondary schools to provide an option for safe, in-person attendance during school year 2020–2021.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Educational Flexibility  
5 for Families Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR SAFE, IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE**

2 **OPTION.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Beginning on the date of enact-  
4 ment of this Act, no amounts are authorized to be appro-  
5 priated for school year 2020–2021 to any elementary  
6 school or secondary school, or any local educational agency  
7 or State educational agency that serves an elementary  
8 school or secondary school, that does not provide an option  
9 for students to attend classes, safely and in-person, at the  
10 school during such school year.

11 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—The terms “elementary school”,  
12 “secondary school”, “local educational agency”, and  
13 “State educational agency” have the meanings given the  
14 terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary  
15 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
