I am requesting \$157,000 in community project funding in fiscal year 2022 for the Benedict Center's Sisters Program to address the underlying needs of women involved in the street sex trade and/or sex trafficking in Milwaukee.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Benedict Center which is located at 1849 N. Martin Luther King Drive, Ste. 101 Milwaukee, WI 53212. Established in 1974, the Benedict Center is a 501 (c) (3) who's mission is to work with victims, offenders, and the community to achieve a system of justice that is fair and treats everyone with dignity and respect. In 2020, the Center served 614 unduplicated women.

The requested funding would support the Sisters Program to help survivors of the street sex trade/ sex trafficking get into housing, treatment, and support services to enhance their health and the safety of the community.
