As you work to develop and advance surface transportation authorization legislation, I submit a project request to provide \$700,000 in that legislation for the South Kinnickinnic Avenue Resurfacing Project in the city of St. Francis, WI. This project will help ensure a safer regional transportation network and bring existing infrastructure into a state of good repair.

The project will resurface the roadway from E. Lunham Avenue to East Howard Avenue, replacing the current asphalt with 4 inches of new asphalt. Funding would be also be used to repair/replace defective curb and gutters along this portion of the roadway along with sidewalks.

The roadway is used as a main route into and out of the city Milwaukee and has between 4600-6400 vehicles travel on it per day. It has not been repaved since 1993.
