A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, in awarding a contract for the procurement of goods or services, to give a preference to offerors that employ veterans.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Boosting Rates of
- 5 American Veteran Employment Act" or the "BRAVE

2 SEC. 2. PREFERENCE FOR OFFERORS EMPLOYING VET-2 ERANS. 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 81 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding after 4 5 section 8128 the following new section: "§ 8129. Preference for offerors employing veterans 6 "(a) Preference.—In awarding a contract for the 7 procurement of goods or services, the Secretary may give 9 a preference to offerors that employ veterans on a fulltime basis. The Secretary shall determine such preference 10 based on the percentage of the full-time employees of the 11 offeror who are veterans. 12 13 "(b) Enforcement Penalties for Misrepresen-TATION.—(1) Any offeror that is determined by the Secretary to have willfully and intentionally misrepresented 15 the veteran status of the employees of the offeror for purposes of subsection (a) may be debarred from contracting 17 with the Department for a period of not less than five 18 19 years. 20 "(2) If the Secretary carries out a debarment under 21 paragraph (1), the Secretary shall commence debarment 22 action against the offeror by not later than 30 days after 23 determining that the offeror willfully and intentionally
