6 (3) The nationality of, and a description of the
7 conduct for which, each alien on the no-fly list or the
8 Federal Bureau of Investigation's Terrorist Screen-
9 ing Database who has been encountered by United
10 States Government personnel at the southwest bor-
11 der, between ports of entry, and subsequently re-
12 leased in the United States, was placed on the no-
13 fly list or the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Ter-
14 rorist Screening Database.

15 (4) Of the aliens described in paragraph (1)
16 who were placed into U.S. Immigration and Customs
17 Enforcement detention, the length of detention and
18 location of detention for each alien.

19 (5) Of the aliens described in paragraph (1),
20 the number expelled pursuant to section 362 of the
21 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 265), ordered
22 removed, granted voluntary departure, removed pur-
23 suant to expedited removal, removed pursuant to a
24 reinstated removal order, and the country to which
25 each was removed.

1 (6) Of the aliens described in paragraph (1),
2 the number referred to the Department of Justice
3 for prosecution under section 275(a) or 276(a) of
4 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
5 1325(a); 8 U.S.C. 1326(a)).

6 (7) The current status of each case for aliens
7 described in paragraph (1) who are still in the
8 United States.
