CONSTITUENT SERVICES

Helping constituents is the most important part of my job. With the delays in the bureaucracy brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic, getting help cutting through the red tape is more important than ever.

For example, I have helped families schedule urgent visa appointments with U.S. Embassies, veterans receive their benefits, community members replace broken cluster mailboxes, people in need expedite their tax refunds, and travelers secure passports for urgent trips.

My office is ready to help you receive a fair and prompt response from our federal government.

Below are just some of the ways we can help:

MILITARY PERSONNEL AND VETERANS

- ✓ Help veterans secure appointments with their VA doctors
- ✓ Recover benefits and pension payments
- ✓ Help with claims, survivor benefits, and discharge
- ✓ Help with questions regarding burials
- ✓ Assist active service members with transfers or pay concerns

GRANTS

- ✓ Help your organization with learning about the process, highlight grant opportunities
- ✓ Provide letters of support

GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES

- ✓ Help retired federal employees receive their pensions and other benefits
- ✓ Help federal employees receive timely responses to their EEOC claims

POSTAL SERVICE (USPS)

- ✓ Work with communities to replace broken mail boxes and fix delivery issues

IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION

- ✓ Expedite qualifying urgent cases
- ✓ Help schedule appointments at embassies
- ✓ Work to get status updates on pending petitions
- ✓ Help update change of address or case information

IRS AND TAXES

- ✓ Facilitate communication with the IRS via the Taxpayer Advocate Service
- ✓ Obtain status updates on late returns

SOCIAL SECURITY AND MEDICARE

- ✓ Request information about eligibility and clarify matters involved Social Security and Medicare benefits
- ✓ Help people inquire about pending benefit applications and progress of disability claims filed with Social Security. Clarify matters involving Social Security and Medicare benefits
