## **A BILL**

To authorize the Gateway Arch in St. Louis, Missouri, to be illuminated by blue and yellow lights in support of Ukraine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Gateway Solidarity*  
5 *Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. ILLUMINATION OF THE GATEWAY ARCH IN SUPPORT**  
7 **OF UKRAINE.**

8 *To show support and solidarity with the Ukrain-*  
9 *ian people, the Secretary of the Interior shall illu-*  
10 *minate the Gateway Arch in St. Louis, Missouri, by*  
11 *blue and yellow lights—*

12 *(A) in 2022, within 15 days following en-*  
13 *actment of this act, for no fewer than 5 consec-*  
14 *utive days; and*

15 *(B) annually on August 24, in recognition*  
16 *of Ukrainian Independence Day, until the Presi-*  
17 *dent reports to Congress that the government of*  
18 *the Russian Federation has ceased its desta-*  
19 *bilizing activities with respect to the sovereignty*  
20 *and territorial integrity of Ukraine.*
