Jiore Craig: Biography

Jiore Craig is the Head of Digital Integrity at the Institute for Strategic Dialogue where she oversees work around mitigating online harms targeting elections. She has extensive international experience, previously spending nine years helping public officials, leaders, media organizations, academic institutions, and civil society organizations across the United States, Asia, Africa, Central America, Australia, and Europe to measure the impact of online influence operations on public opinion, elections, and democratic systems. Jiore was formerly a Vice President at a global public opinion research firm, where she built a digital practice based in public opinion research serving leaders in five continents. Her expertise has been highlighted on NBC Nightly News and her work is cited in The Washington Post, New York Magazine, The L.A. Times, The New Yorker, Voice of America, Bloomberg, and The Atlantic. She has been a guest lecturer on the election disinformation marketplace at New York University, a SXSW panelist on the threat of election disinformation, and frequently speaks to the threat and mitigation of election disinformation in public settings.
