WHEREAS, The women of one-fourth of the States of the Union are entitled to vote for President in November; and

WHEREAS, The women of Australia, New Zealand, a large part of Canada and several important European countries, now vote upon equal terms with men; and

WHEREAS, The unenfranchised women of the United States are as intelligent, law abiding and patriotic as any women in the world, be it

RESOLVED: That we, the citizens of Providence.R.I.in mass meeting assembled at Congdon St. Church do hereby call upon all candidates for member of the House of Representatives and the United States Senate to pledge their aid, if elected, by vote and influence to secure the submission of a Federal Woman Suffrage Amendment for ratification by the Legislature of the several States.
