

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H. RES. 1295
OFFERED BY M R. SCOTT

Strike all after the resolved clause and insert the following:

1 That the Secretary of Education, Miguel Cardona, is
2 directed to transmit to the House of Representatives, not
3 later than 14 days after the date of the adoption of this
4 resolution, copies of all documents, memoranda, legal
5 opinions, notes from meetings, records (including tele-
6 phone and electronic mail records), correspondence (elec-
7 tronic or otherwise), and other communications, or any
8 portion of any such communications, to the extent that
9 any such one or more items are within the possession of
10 the Secretary and refer or relate to the following:

11 (1) Impact analyses, cost benefit analyses, eligi-
12 bility determinations, and budget estimates gen-
13 erated by the Department of Education, including
14 any estimates and assumptions used to generate
15 each analysis or estimate, relating to the public serv-
16 ice loan forgiveness waiver announced on October 6,
17 2021, and the income-driven repayment waiver an-
18 nounced on April 19, 2022.

1 (2) Meetings and conversations that included
2 discussions of the number of borrowers potentially
3 eligible to benefit and the amount of outstanding
4 debt potentially affected, budget estimates, impact
5 analyses, and other related discussions regarding the
6 public service loan forgiveness waiver announced on
7 October 6, 2021, and the income-driven repayment
8 waiver announced on April 19, 2022, including any
9 formal or informal discussions held between the
10 White House officials, the Department of Education,
11 Members of Congress, researchers and academics,
12 and any group or organization advocating for such
13 waivers.

14 (3) Budget estimates, impact analyses, cost
15 benefit analyses, and related estimates regarding the
16 public service loan forgiveness waiver announced on
17 October 6, 2021, and the income-driven repayment
18 waiver announced on April 19, 2022, arising from or
19 used for purposes of discussions held between the
20 Executive Office of the President, the Department of
21 Education, the Department of the Treasury, and the
22 Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection.

23 (4) Discussions and deliberations between De-
24 partment of Education employees and officials, in-
25 cluding political appointees and career staff, relating

1 to making public budget estimates, impact analyses,
2 and the number of borrowers potentially eligible to
3 benefit and the amount of outstanding debt poten-
4 tially affected under the public service loan forgive-
5 ness waiver announced on October 6, 2021, and the
6 income-driven repayment waiver announced on April
7 19, 2022.

8 (5) Budget estimates, impact analyses, cost
9 benefit analyses, and the number of borrowers po-
10 tentially eligible to benefit and the amount of out-
11 standing debt potentially affected under the public
12 service loan forgiveness waiver announced on Octo-
13 ber 6, 2021, and the income-driven repayment waiv-
14 er announced on April 19, 2022.
