GUIDELINES:

Artwork entered in the contest can be **no larger** than 26"X26"x4" and no more than 15lbs. (with frame if winner) and must be an original in concept, design and execution.

The artwork may be:

Oil, acrylics, and watercolor

DRAWINGS

Pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, and markers

COLLAGE

two dimensional

PRINTS

Lithographs, silkscreen, and block prints

MIXED MEDIA

Use of two mediums

PHOTOGRAPHY

COMPUTER GENERATED ART
