Dear Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting funding for Economic Mobility Resource Hub in fiscal year 2022.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of South San Francisco, located at South San Francisco City Hall, 400 Grand Avenue, South San Francisco, CA 94080.

The funding would be used to fund workforce development services provided through JobTrain at the Economic Mobility Resource Hub, bringing resources directly to North San Mateo County residents facing job loss and job insecurity in an accessible location in South San Francisco's lowest income neighborhood. Workforce development programs offered at the Hub will center on supportive, case-management driven services supporting the whole person. In addition, the project will dramatically improve access to job training and placement services for the region's most vulnerable residents, because it will establish a physical center that is rooted in the community it serves and that can be conveniently accessed by people walking or taking transit from the most heavily impacted neighborhoods.
