UNANIMOUS-CONSENT AGREEMENTS

Ordered, That at 1 p.m. on Friday, Nov 21, 1969, the Senate proceed to vote on the nomination of Clement F. Haynsworth, Jr., of South Carolina, to be an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States

(Nov 18, 1969)

Ordered, That on Friday, Nov 21, 1969, after the Senate convenes, that there be a period of 30 minutes for the transaction of routine morning business as in legislative session, and that the time thereafter until 1 o'clock be equally divided and controlled by the majority and minority leaders or persons designated by them
