Biden, President of the United States, requesting that the presidential budget request for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 include \$355 million dollars for the National Labor Relations Board, a level that would restore the agency's funding to its FY 2010 level when adjusted for inflation. This was a joint letter with Subcommittee on Health, Employment, Labor, and Pensions Chair Mark DeSaulnier.
