I am requesting \$220,416 in funding for Whitpain Township in fiscal year 2023 through the Interior Subcommittee and the Environmental Protection Agency State and Tribal Assistance Grants.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Ambler Alley Storm Sewer Project, located at 960 Wentz Road, Blue Bell, PA 19422.

The funding would be used for to install storm sewer piping along Ambler Alley. The proposed storm sewer project will assist with alleviating existing drainage concerns along Ambler Alley which will benefit the community by capturing and providing proper drainage of stormwater runoff. In addition, as the Ambler Alley roadway is set to serve as a direct access road off the proposed Wissahickon Park property, making the roadway more structurally sound from a stormwater management perspective, which is both important and beneficial to the surrounding community.
