

Windsor Locks – 117th Federal Funding Snapshot

Topline Numbers:

- \$6.1 million in direct American Rescue Plan Act funding
- \$23.8 million in Federal grant funding
- 26.3 million in Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act funding

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:

- The Town of Windsor Locks has received more than **\$6.1 million** in **ARP** funding:
 - \$1.3million in Local Aid
 - \$2.4 in County Aid
 - \$2.3 million in Educational Aid
- Windsor Locks is currently seeking applications from small businesses for one-time grant payments and has so far allocated ARP funds toward to following expenditures:
 - \$1.2 million for replacement of lost revenue
 - \$95,000 for housing, food, and heat insecurity
 - \$29,000 for Transport vehicle for Youth Services Programming and Social Services food pantry
 - \$5,000 for Bickford resident activity fund
 - \$15,000 Recast City small scale manufacturing program
 - \$60,000 Expansion of Small Business Micro Loan Program
 - \$10,000 Community needs fund, formation of 501c3

Federal Grants:

- **Bradley International Airport**
 - **\$14.7 million** from the Department of Transportation for Taxiway Reconstruction
 - **\$7.9 million** for COVID mitigation efforts

- **\$712,000** for economic relief for on-site car rental, parking, and concession stands
- **\$497,000** in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 5 Windsor Locks restaurants:
 - **\$285,000** for Skyline Restaurant and Banquet, 106 Ella Grasso Tpke.
 - **\$127,000** for Pool Table Magic, 75 Ella Grasso Tpke.
 - **\$35,000** for Luppoleto Brewing Company, 20 Main Street
 - **\$27,000** for Izumi Japanese Steak House & Sushi Bar, 25 Ella Grasso Tpke.
 - **\$23,000** for Skooter's Restaurant, 50 Ella Grasso Tpke.
- **\$10,000** Sustaining the Humanities through the American Rescue Plan (SHARP) Capacity grant to the New England Air Museum for expanded digital and virtual outreach

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA):

- **\$17.3 million** for local projects on the State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP)
- **\$9 million** Airport Infrastructure Grant for Bradley International Airport to streamline the baggage system and alleviate terminal congestion
