- [H.R. 4690](#) (Rep. Jared Huffman), To reauthorize and amend the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act, and for other purposes. "Sustaining America's Fisheries for the Future Act of 2021." *Amendments to H.R. 4690 must be drafted to the amendment in the nature of a substitute, attached to this notice.*

- Adopting as amended and ordering reported unfavorably: [H.Res. 1252](#) (Rep. Pete Stauber), Of inquiry directing the Secretary of the Interior to transmit certain documents to the House of Representatives relating to the mineral withdrawal within the Superior National Forest.
- Adopting as amended and ordering reported unfavorably: [H.Res. 1253](#) (Ranking Member Bruce Westerman), Of inquiry directing the Secretary of the Interior to transmit certain documents to the House of Representatives relating to the actions of the Department of the Interior's Departmental Ethics Office.
