

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE**  
**TO H.R. 3304**  
**OFFERED BY Mr. Takano**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Advancing Uniform  
3 Transportation Opportunities for Veterans Act” or the  
4 “AUTO for Veterans Act”.

**5 SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-**  
**6 FAIRS PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL AUTO-**  
**7 MOBILE OR OTHER ADAPTED EQUIPMENT.**

8 Section 3903(a) of title 38, United States Code, is  
9 amended—

10 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “paragraph  
11 (2)” and inserting “paragraphs (2) and (3)”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following new  
13 paragraph:

14 “(3) The Secretary may provide or assist in providing  
15 an eligible person with an additional automobile or other  
16 conveyance under this chapter—

1           “(A) if more than 25 years have elapsed since  
2           the eligible person most recently received an auto-  
3           mobile or other conveyance under this chapter; or

4           “(B) beginning on the day that is 10 years  
5           after date of the enactment of the AUTO for Vet-  
6           erans Act, if more than 10 years have elapsed since  
7           the eligible person most recently received an auto-  
8           mobile or other conveyance under this chapter.”.

9   **SEC. 3. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TREATMENT**  
10                   **OF CERTAIN VEHICLE MODIFICATIONS AS**  
11                   **MEDICAL SERVICES.**

12           Section 1701(6) of title 38, United States Code, is  
13   amended by adding at the end the following new subpara-  
14   graph:

15                   “(I) The provision of medically necessary  
16           van lifts, raised doors, raised roofs, air-condi-  
17           tioning, and wheelchair tiedowns for passenger  
18           use.”.

19   **SEC. 4. MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN HOUSING LOAN FEE.**

20           (a) **EXTENSION.**—The loan fee table in section  
21   3729(b)(2) of title 38, United States Code, is amended  
22   by striking “January 14, 2031” each place it appears and  
23   inserting “June 1, 2031”.
