This markup will take place in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, as well as remotely using Cisco Webex online video conferencing. Members will receive Webex participant access information by email before the markup. No staff from member's offices will be allowed in the Committee room. However, one staffer from each members' office may join the markup remotely as an attendee on Webex. Each designated staff attendee should register at the provided link by no later than Tuesday, September 20, 2022, at 5 p.m. (EDT). The Democratic staff briefing will be held immediately following the bipartisan briefing. The Republican staff briefing will be announced separately.
