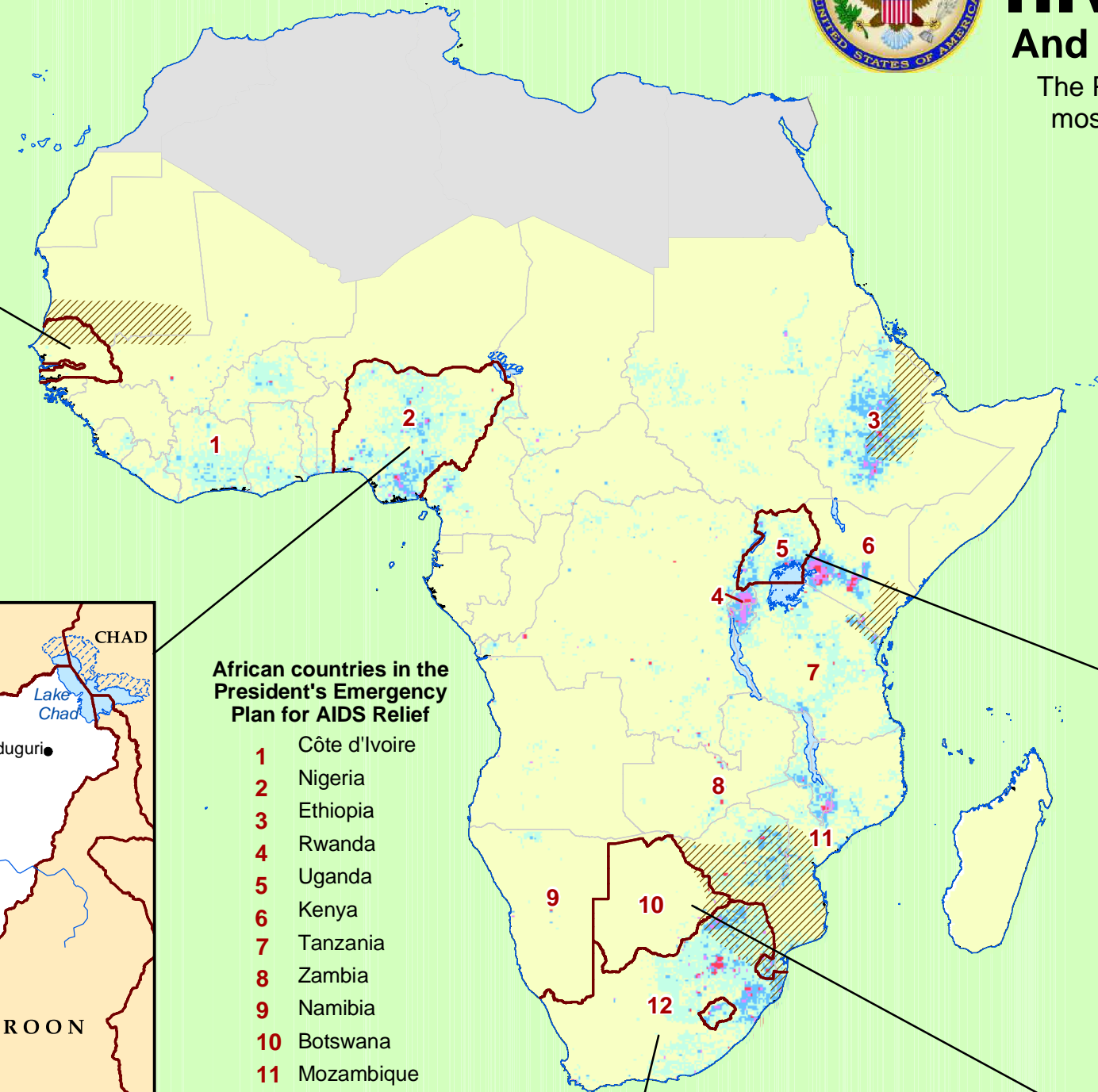
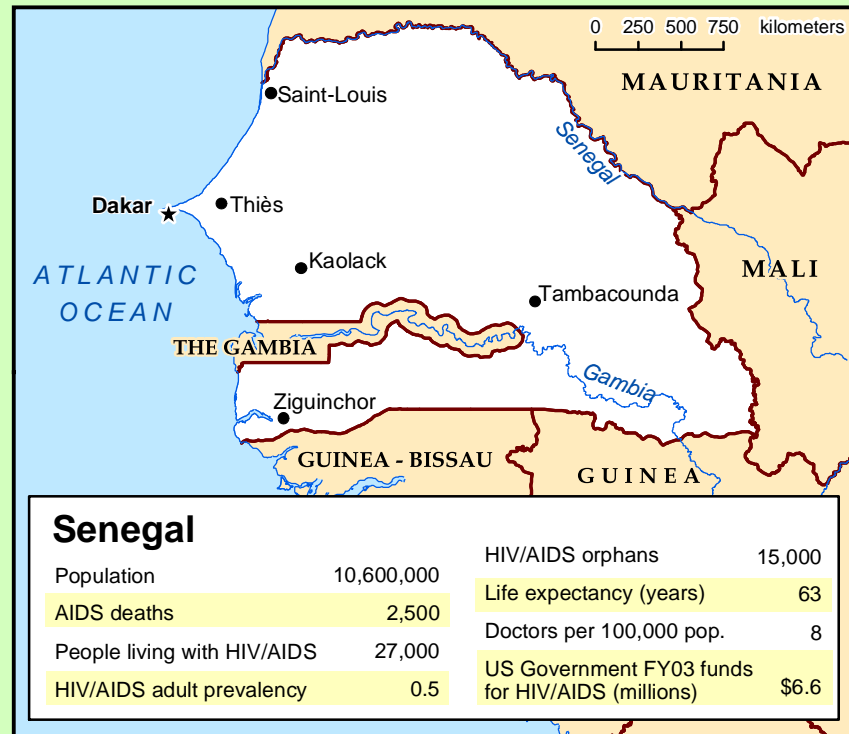




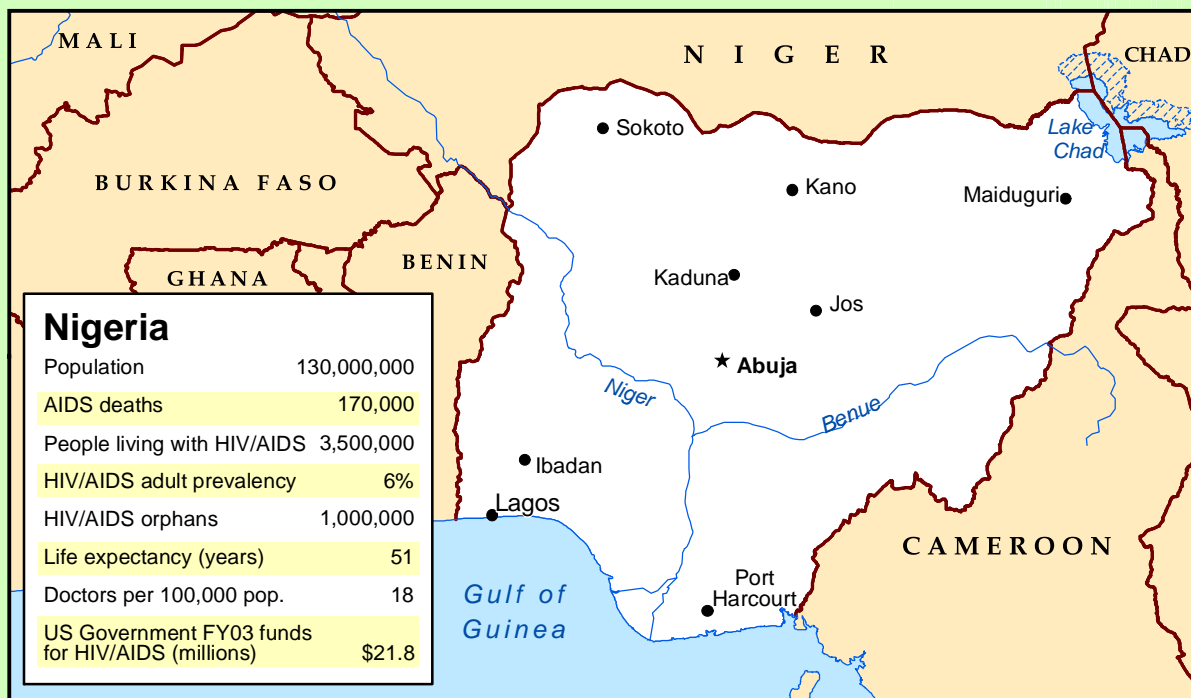
HIV/AIDS in Sub-Saharan Africa

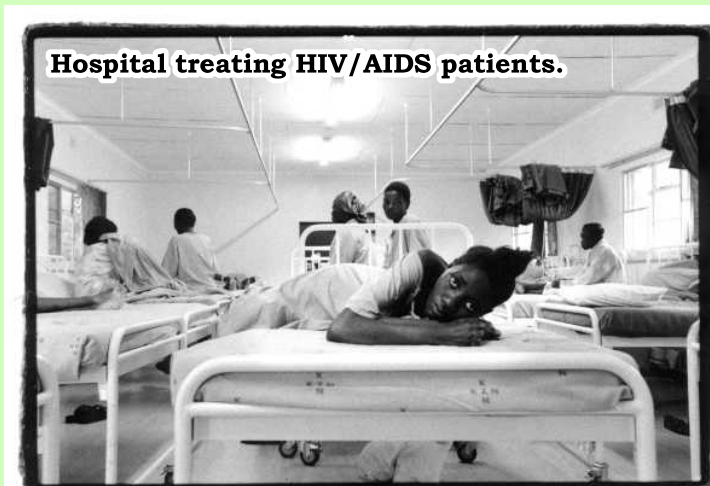
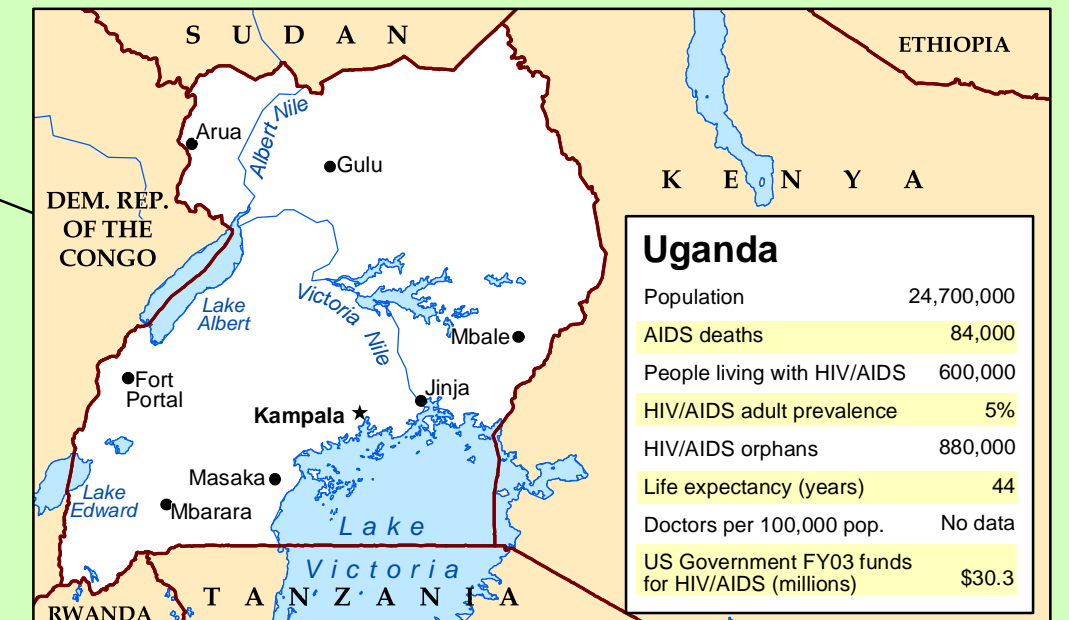
