By the Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau:
In paragraph six on page four of the Second Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rule Making, WT Docket No. 97-82, FCC 97-342 (rel. October 16, 1997), the third sentence of the section entitled "Disaggregation" contained incorrect statements. The section is corrected to read as follows:

- Disaggregation. A ny C block licensee may elect to disaggregate one-half of its spectrum ( 15 M Hz of its 30 MHz ) and surrender such spectrum to the Commission for reauction. A licensee must disaggregate spectrum for all of the Basic Trading A rea (BTA) licenses it holds within any $M$ ajor Trading A rea (M TA), but need not disaggregate the licenses it holds in other M TAs. In return, the licensee will have the proportionate amount, i.e., $50 \%$, of its outstanding debt on the disaggregated licenses forgiven. Fifty percent of the down payment for those licenses will be applied towards the debt for the retained spectrum; the licensee will not get a refund or credit of the other $50 \%$ of its deposit. The licensee will be prohibited from rebidding for this spectrum, or otherwise acquiring it in the secondary market, for two years from the date of the start of the reauction. C block licensees electing this option will repay over eight equal payments (beginning with the payment due on $M$ arch 31,1998 ) all interest that has accrued and was unpaid due to the payment suspension, adjusted to reflect the reduction in debt obligation. A ny prior installment payments made will be credited in full against those amounts.
