> Dear Dr. Vogl:
> I would strongly recommend that body hair (excluding pubic hair) be included in the Federal Drug Testing program. I
have been using hair testing for pre-employment drug screening in three of our John Deere Plants. Approximately 15%
of the candidates had head hair that was too short to test. Body hair, normally axillary hair, enabled us to test all of these
candidates. When we used urine for pre-employment drug testing our positive rate was approximately 3%. With hair
testing, our positive rate was 14.5%. We did not get complaints about the methodology.
