I object to the rules that equate inability to produce a specimen with refusal to test. These rules are unjust.

SAMHSA needs to mandate the use of alternative tests -- oral fluid, hair; sweat patches, etc., -- for anyone who requests these, but especially for those who claim to suffer from shy bladder.
