# FARM SERVICE AGENCY ADDENDUM TO THE PROVIDER AGREEMENT TO ELECTRONICALLY FILE AND MAINTAIN GRAIN WAREHOUSE RECEIPTS

This Addendum between\_

(Provider) and the Farm Service Agency (FSA) authorizes the Provider to establish and maintain a database and system, referred to as a central filing system (CFS) for the purpose of electronically filing grain electronic warehouse receipts issued under the United States Warehouse Act (USWA) and permits the Provider to accept the filing of electronic warehouse receipts from other than USWA licensed warehouse operators in such electronic data filing system. Such electronically filed warehouse receipts for grain are hereafter referred to as "Electronic Warehouse Receipts (EWRs)."

Grain is defined as all products commonly classed as grain such as wheat, corn, oats, barley, rye, flaxseed, rough, brown, and milled rice, sunflower seeds, soybeans, emmer, sorghum, safflower seed, triticale, millet, oilseeds, pulses other than dry edible beans, and such other products as are ordinarily stored in grain warehouses, subject to the disapproval of the FSA.

This Addendum sets forth the Provider's minimum requirements for EWR record formatting, reporting requirements and the protocols to be used in the transmission of such information.

#### I. Receipt Record Data Requirements

FSA, in administration of the USWA, the regulations found at 7 CFR Part 735, the Provider Agreement To Electronically File and Maintain Warehouse Receipts and United States Act Documents and this Addendum, may at any time require the Provider to furnish information beyond the minimum requirements shown in this Addendum.

A. Required Information

The Provider shall, at a minimum, make the elements listed below available to every USWA and non-USWA licensed warehouse operator issuing EWRs in the CFS. The Provider shall ensure that all of these fields are completed by all warehouse operators. The Provider shall advise warehouse operators that it is the warehouse operator's responsibility to supply the necessary data to complete each element.

USWA license number, if applicable\*

Receipt number and License type, US if Federally licensed, NL if not licensed or the two letter Postal abbreviation if State licensed, will be displayed in front of the receipt number and will be an integral part of the receipt number

Issuance date (date issuance batch file is received and accepted in the Providers system) Receipt status

Indicate whether the receipt is "Not Negotiable" or "Negotiable" according to the nature of the receipt

Cancellation date (date cancellation batch file is received and accepted in the Providers system) Name of warehouse

Location of warehouse (City)

Location of warehouse (State)

B. Additional Information

The Provider shall, at a minimum, make the element listed below available to every USWA and non-USWA licensed warehouse operator issuing EWRs in the CFS. The Provider shall advise warehouse operators that it is the warehouse operator's responsibility to supply the necessary data to complete this element. This Addendum does not restrict the number of fields that may be made available to warehouse operators.

Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) Agreement (Y or N) Quality factors applicable to the specific grain

C. Required elements that can be modified without the warehouse operator being the holder

FSA will allow the warehouse operator to modify the elements, "date to which storage has been paid", "storage start date", or "prepaid in or out charges" without being the holder of the EWR. The Provider shall notify the current holder of the EWR of any changes.

D. Converting Electronic To Paper

When converting from an electronic to a paper warehouse receipt, the Provider shall advise the warehouse operator to print on the face of the paper warehouse receipt the EWR number.

#### II. Transmission of Data

Upon request by FSA, all transmissions of data shall be secured and transmitted via telecommunications hardware and software according to the requirements described in Attachment I Provider Specifications for interfacing with Warehouse Examiners' Communications Software (WECS).

### **III.** Terms and Conditions For USWA Licensed Warehouse Operators

The following information must be recorded on all EWR's.

The statements:

Incorporated or Unincorporated and if incorporated, under what laws.

Insured, to what extent, by the warehouse operator against loss by fire, lightning and other risks.

Weight was determined by a weigher licensed under the USWA.

Grade was determined by a "Federal Grain Inspection Service grader", a "Grader licensed under the USWA", or "Not graded on request of depositor".

The grade or other class stated in this receipt is in accordance with the Official Grain Grading Standards of the United States. If the grade of grain is that for which no official grain standards of the United States are in effect, the grade or other class shall be stated in accordance with the standards, if any, adopted by the local board of trade, chamber of commerce, or by the grain trade generally in the locality in which the warehouse is located, subject to the authorization of the FSA, or in the absence of these standards, in accordance with any standards authorized for the purpose by the FSA.

The applicable charges claimed by the warehouse operator for storage and other services.

In the event the relationship existing between the warehouse operator and any depositor is not that of strictly disinterested custodianship, a statement setting forth the actual relationship.

## IV. Terms and Conditions For State or Non-Licensed Warehouse Operators

The following information must be recorded on all EWR's.

The statements:

Incorporated or Unincorporated and if incorporated, under what laws.

Insured, to what extent, by the warehouse operator against loss by fire, lightning and other risks.

The authority, that the warehouse operator issues warehouse receipts under, state warehouse code for state licensed warehouses or Uniform Commercial Code for non-licensed warehouses.

The amount of bond or financial assurance backing the receipt.

Weight was determined by a weigher licensed or approved under what laws or authority or "Not weighed on request of depositor".

Grade was determined by a grader licensed or approved under what laws or authority or "Not graded on request of depositor".

The standards on which the grade or other class is stated in this receipt.

The applicable charges claimed by the warehouse operator for storage and other services.

In the event the relationship existing between the warehouse operator and any depositor is not that of strictly disinterested custodianship, a statement setting forth the actual relationship.

<u>NOTE 1</u> – The XX prefix in receipt number will signify the type of license the receipt was issued under. If the location is federally licensed, then the prefix is US. If the location is state licensed, then the prefix is the postal state code. (i.e. GA is Georgia). If the location is not licensed, then the prefix is NL. The number following the prefix must be unique for each warehouse and within the range assigned to that warehouse by USDA.

<u>NOTE 2</u> – The end-user will be responsible for entering all correct weight fields. The fields cannot be zero. They will not be calculated by the provider.

<u>NOTE 3</u> – The DPS State Code and DPS County Code fields are the CCC assign county and state codes for the county office that "Downloads Receipt for Price Support" (DPS). The county office will be responsible for including these fields in a transmission file when requesting the receipt. The provider will then update these fields and "lock" the receipt to that county office, thus preventing multiple county offices from processing a loan or LDP. Once a receipt has been "locked" to that county, only that county can "unlock" or "release" the receipt. <u>NOTE 4</u> – The Producer Holder ID field is used for sending acknowledgments to the grower/producer when a receipt is issued or transferred under loan. If this field is empty, no acknowledgment will be sent to the grower. The ID is assigned by the Provider.
