## Creating a Simple NPMS Mapping Application

The Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) has discontinued providing open access to the National Pipeline Mapping System (NPMS) Internet mapping application. As an alternative to the Internet mapping application, OPS has researched several GIS software vendors which offer free or low-cost GIS shareware for viewing GIS data.
