*A new initiative of the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational & Cultural Affairs*

### **PLUS Program Eligibility Requirements:**

**Competition for the PLUS Program is merit-based and open to anyone who is:**

- + A citizen, national or permanent resident qualified to hold a valid passport issued by the country in which you reside.
- + Enrolled in an undergraduate degree program (at time of application) and has completed at least two years of undergraduate study, with a minimum GPA of B+, or "Very Good."
- + Academic major in a field within the liberal arts, humanities or social sciences.
- + Minimum English language proficiency of 450 TOEFL/ITP or 133 TOEFL/CBT at the time of application.
- + Able to begin studies in the United States Spring 2005.
- + From an under-represented and/or economically disadvantaged community.
- + Committed to returning home upon completion of the program.
