

5. PRINTED MATERIALS

A limited number of popular weather and climate books are usually available at local bookstores. Many textbooks can be ordered and purchased from bookstores catering to colleges. University and public libraries have numerous popular meteorology books and periodicals. Participating libraries within the Federal Depository system are sources of numerous weather-related government publications and climatological data.

Weatherwise magazine has many interesting articles and features. Pertinent articles also appear in *The Physics Teacher*, *The Science Teacher*, *The Earth Scientist*, *Science Scope*, and *Science and Children*. These articles contain useful information for demonstration, experiments, and other learning experiences for preschool through college. *Science and Children* contains a section "Geography and Weather" by H.M. Mogil and H.T. Collins. Reviews of pertinent books appear in *Science Books and Films* under "Earth Science."
