APPENDIX B

Components of State Oral Health Programs*

- 1. Provide leadership to address oral health.
- 2. Develop and maintain a state oral health plan
- Develop and promote policies for better oral health and to improve health systems.
- 4. Establish and maintain state-based oral health surveillance system.
- 5. Provide oral health communication and education to policymakers and the public.
- 6. Build linkages with partners interested in reducing the burden of oral diseases.
- 7. Integrate, coordinate and implement population-based interventions.
- 8. Build community capacity to implement community-level interventions.
- 9. Develop health systems interventions to facilitate quality dental care access.
- 10. Leverage resources to adequately fund public health functions.
