

## TM Workshop Outline – Functions





The 5 TM functions you will need to use and understand are:

- Account Unlocking
- **Bulk Enrollment**
- **Enrollment Mgmt**
- **Proctor PW Search**
- Web Reporting

Each of these are explained in detail in the TM Guide.

## TM Workshop Outline – Main Points

- The role of MarineNet Training Manager is an important and powerful one...
   Treat it with care and respect, and safeguard the TM account password!
- As proctors for MarineNet E-Testing, TMs are responsible for maintaining the integrity of the Marine Corps testing process. Study the E-Testing SOP carefully before serving as a test proctor!
- Include the MarineNet TM Account as an important item in your turnover file for your billet.
