9 FAM 41.111 N1 Power To Grant and Refuse Visas May Not Be Delegated

The determination of an alien's classification and eligibility to receive a visa is the statutory responsibility of the consular officer and may not be delegated to any other officer [except as provided in 22 CFR 41.111(b)] or to a member of the clerical staff.

9 FAM 41.111 N2 Use of Consular Officer's Diplomatic Title on Diplomatic Visas

A consular officer assigned to a diplomatic mission may use the officer's diplomatic title in issuing diplomatic visas if the officer's consular commission has not been recognized by the government to which accredited.
