



## CBIAC Technical Area Task Program

The **Chemical and Biological Defense Information Analysis Center (CBIAC)** is a full-service Department of Defense (DoD) Information Analysis Center (IAC) operated by Battelle Memorial Institute under contract SP0700-00-D-3180 to the Defense Technical Information Center (DTIC). CBIAC services are available to DoD and Federal Agencies, DoD and Federal Agency Contractors, State and Local Government Agencies and Emergency Responders.

The **CBIAC** maintains three distinct programs in order to accomplish its mission and objectives: The **Core Program**, the **Knowledge Management and Development (KM&D) Program**, and the **Technical Area Task (TAT) Program**.

The **CBIAC TAT Program** provides the Chemical and Biological (CB) Defense and Homeland Security (HLS) communities a competitively awarded, quick, convenient, and responsive task-order contract vehicle for independently funded analytical and/or technical efforts.

The **CBIAC TAT Program** provides access to technical expertise, state-of-the-art facilities, and capabilities to perform CB Defense and HLS related technical efforts. The processes and mechanism associated with the TAT Program require minimal effort from the task-sponsoring agency. Costs associated with use of this contract include a 4-percent DTIC fee.

TATs can be funded in support of, but not limited to, the following areas:

- Information Collection and Compilation
- Studies and Analyses
- Hardware Development
- Laboratory Studies (Including Surety Work)
- Design and Development of Models, Simulations, and Databases
- Test and Evaluation of Materials, Components, and Systems
- Technical Consulting
- Training Tabletop/Field Exercises
- Support of Conferences, Symposia, and Working Groups
- Engineering Design, Prototyping, and Low-Rate Production.



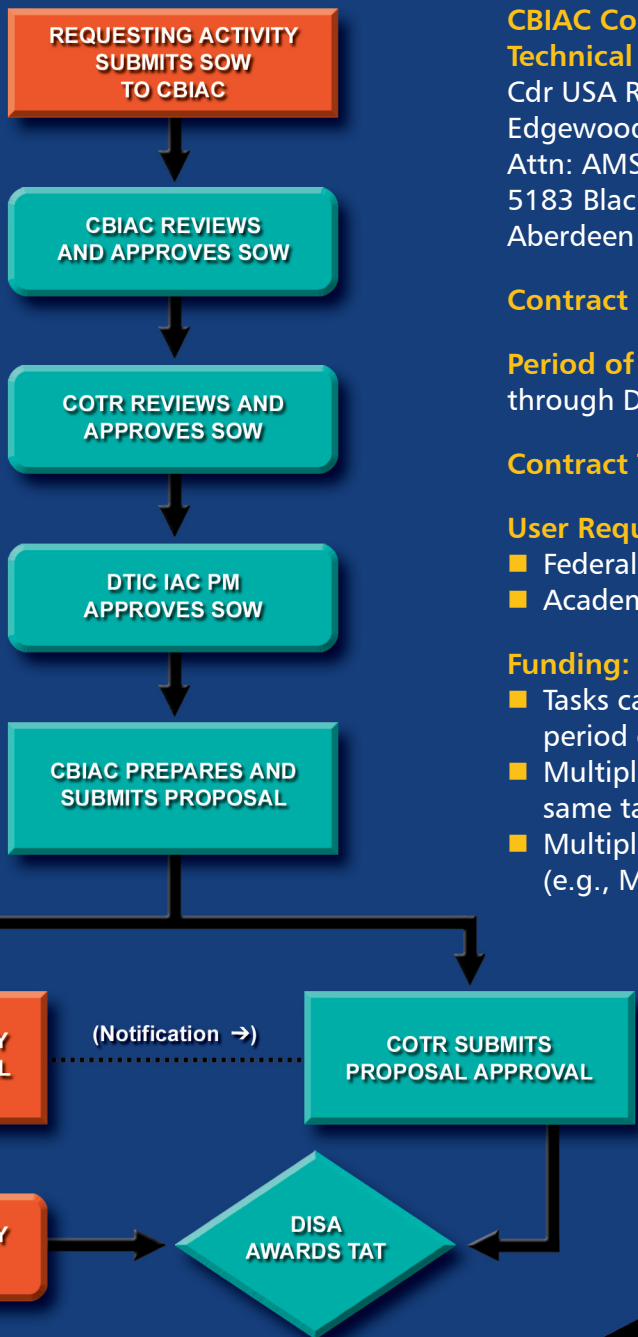
