#### Qualified Areas

#### 13 CFR §126.103



Three categories -- Urban, Rural, Native American

- ✓ Metropolitan Area Census Tracts (HUD) 7,000
- ✓ Non-metropolitan Counties 900
  - Median household income is less than 80% of the non-metropolitan state level (Census)
  - Unemployment rate that is not less than 140% of the state-wide average (BLS)
- ✓ All federally recognized Indian reservations as defined by external boundary (*Update pending*)





- Designation period:
  - -- Urban is concurrent with census (ten years)
  - -- Rural reflects employment, income adjustments (one year)
  - -- Native American involves Federal recognition and boundary changes. (Definition of 'Indian Country' forthcoming)

### HUBZone SBCArea Update

✓ SBA's most recent reauthorization contained provision that allows for a three-year **grandfathering** for areas that at one time were HUBZone certified, but lost the designation due to a change in income or employment (aka - redesignated area).

Public Law 106-554



# Requirements For A HUBZone Small Business Concern (SBC) 13 CFR §126.103

#### ✓ FOUR REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a small business by SBA standards;
- Concern must be owned and controlled *only* by US citizens, Community Development Corporations or Indian tribes;
- The *principal office* of the concern must be located in a HUBZone; and
- At least 35% of the concern's employees must reside in a HUBZone.

### The Certification Process

IMPROVED -- Entirely revamped on-line application available since Jan. 1, 2001

- ✓ Processing time 30 -- 45 days
- ✓ SBA decision in writing



## Certification Process Details 13 CFR §126.300-306

- ✓ Firm must apply to SBA for certification
- ✓ Format:
  - *electronic* or paper
  - electronic can shave 10 days off decision timeline; paper strongly discouraged
  - available at www.sba.gov/hubzone



# 19.1303 -- Status as a Qualified HUBZone **SBC**



- ✓ HUBZone status determined by SBA
- ✓ List of qualified firms on the SBA HUBZone web site
- ✓ Joint ventures eligible if with HUB, 8(a), WOB
- ✓ Non-manufacturers must furnish the product of a HUBZone SB manufacturer (will be updated by FAR Council)

### Maintaining HUBZone Status

13 CFR §126. Subpart E

✓ No term limit

✓ All HUBZone firms, however, must annually self certify and do so within 30 calendar days of certification anniversary following notice by agency



# HUBZone SBC Ongoing Obligations 13 CFR §126.501

- ✓ Provide immediate notice of any material change that affects eligibility
- ✓ Notification failure can result in immediate decertification
- ✓ If the firm reapplies, it must explain why it failed to notify SBA
- ✓ SBA, if not satisfied, may decline to certify



### Program Examinations

13 CFR §126. Subpart D

- ✓ Eligibility verification
- ✓ Scope of review
  - Verification: eligibility requirements at time of application and examination
  - location, ownership & employment percentage requirements
- ✓ Time frame when notified of a possible material change in status or random, at the discretion of SBA
