**Step 4:** Click the "Next" button.

**Step 5:** Enter a treatment name (e.g. Unit 1 Invasive Species Seeding).

**Step 6:** Select a treatment category (e.g. Invasive Species).

**Step 7:** Select a treatment type (e.g. Prevention/Seeding).



- Part 2 Identify Communities at Risk
- **Step 1:** Click on the "Select Communities at Risk" link with in the "Impacted Communities" portlet.
- **Step 2:** Confirm that you wish to associate communities at risk for the identified project and treatment, and then click the "Select Communities" button.
- **Step 3:** Click on the "Get CAR" button.
- **Step 4:** Click "OK" in response to the pop-up message.
- **Step 5:** Draw a bounding rectangle around the community or communities that you wish to associate with the treatment.



- **Step 6:** Click on the "Add all entries above to the CAR list" link within the "Query/Selection Results" window.
- **Step 7:** Close the "Query/Selection Results" window.
- **Step 8:** Click on the "Submit" button that appears at the top of the rectangle that displays the list of selected communities within the UseMap tool.
- Part 3 Identify Impacted Species
- **Step 1:** Click "Select T&E Species" link within the Impacted Species portlet.
- **Step 2:** Select the first threatened or endangered species that you would like to associate with this activity.
- Step 3: Click the "Save" button.
