Seminal points he offered for establishing inspection and evaluation units were:

- Get effective, experienced lead-
- Hire talented staff with diverse experience.
- Be bold in the selection of and approach to your work.
- Cooperate with audits and investigations.
- Make your work products more readable and visually appealing.
- Participate in peer professional groups, especially the Roundtable.
- Have fun!

Johnnie introduced Stephen Smith, Farm Credit Administration IG and I&E Committee member, thanking him for attending. Johnnie also noted with appreciation the tireless leadership efforts of George Grob and Debbie Holmes in making the January I&E Roundtable so successful. A testament to that success: the January

meeting hosted 39 persons, a record for Roundtable attendance.

ROUNDTABLE PROJECTS

At the January meeting, I&E Roundtable Chair George Grob asked Roundtable members to report on the progress of ongoing projects. The Purchase Card project was discussed by Brent Weston and Gerard Fahy from the Department of Education OIG Analysis and Inspection Service, which has the lead on this project. A report on the **Travel** Cards project was presented by Dennis Raymond, Department of Labor OIG Division of Program Evaluations. Dennis' office has taken the lead on this project and is currently completing its inhouse report. Once it is completed, that office may compile information from other OIG offices that have done similar work.

As in the past when HHS OIG has offered training opportunities, there was an overwhelming response, and the three available openings went quickly to the first to respond to Debbie's email.
