Of these, 23,424 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 21,935 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 21,935 cases, 41 were excluded due to missing drug type. Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
