Of these, 18,835 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Additionally, 1,255 cases were excluded due to incomplete guideline application information (1,237) or missing drug type (18). Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
