¹Of the 59,846 cases, 23,542 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 23,424 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 21,935 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 21,935 cases, 43 were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing drug type (41) or missing criminal history information (2).
